
# What's new in RadarOpus v3.3

New implementations and improvements of version 3.3 as compared to 3.2

RadarOpus **3.3** will be delivered initially as a **Live Update** over 3.2, and as a **Full Installer** (to include new Synthesis Translations and new Synthesis Views).



#### **SUMMARY**

RadarOpus v3.3 is divided into two parts, as follows:

PAYABLE - CREATE AND ANALYSE BUNDLE (requires silver, gold or diamond engine)

FREE - NEW FEATURES, IMPROVEMENTS AND FIXES

# **OVERVIEW**

#### PREMIUM FEATURES – CREATE AND ANALYSE BUNDLE

#### • New - Create Personal Materia Medica

- New editing tools allow you to create your own Materia Medica derived from personal clinical experience, seminar notes, compilation of existing material in RadarOpus or from various books and online sources.
  - Create Materia Medica for any existing remedy from the 8448 in our database!

#### • New - Smart Symptom Edit (Patient File)

O Write symptoms (e.g. Mind Anxiety), then in the row below write "=" followed by the number of symptoms written above (e.g. "2") + the new symptom(s) (e.g. "night") then press TAB. The initial symptoms + the new symptom(s) will appear below. e.g. "mind anxiety =2 night" becomes "mind anxiety night". The tool is made to speed up your work when inserting symptoms in the Patient File. Example below:

#### New - Analyse with the Master Score (new Analysis strategy, sold separately from bundle)

- o Dr. Farokh Master has created an Analysis strategy which weights your analysis based on an approval rating of each author.
- Reliable sources are given higher approval and accorded a stronger weighting in the Analysis compared to a less-confirmed source.
- o This allows you to analyse your case in a very similar way to Dr. Master!

#### • New - Analyse by comparing 3 remedies side-by-side in a graph

- This tool allows you to extract up to 3 remedies for side-by-side comparison.
- Extract a graph displaying the total number of symptoms of each remedy from the different chapters of any repertory.
- This allows for a detailed study and comparison of the *sphere of action* of each of the 3 remedies that you may be considering as a prescription.

#### New - Analyse with multiple strategies in one interface

#### • New - Choose your Favorite Repertories and Materia Medica

 R-click any Repertory or Materia Medica and choose 'Add favorite' – the item is starred and the option to move it to the top of the Table of contents (TOC) is given.

#### New - Add linked symptoms from Concepts repertories straight to the clipboard

- o In Concepts repertories, there are links to symptoms in Synthesis Adonis.
- You can take any number of those linked symptoms to a clipboard with a few mouse clicks.





 Expert tip - Very useful when looking up pathologies and the list of common symptoms (to know which ones are less useful in individualizing the case).

#### • New - Optional password protection

- Password protection remains a prerequisite for medical and professional Homeopaths saving patient information due to GDPR and HIPAA regulations.
- For part-time Homeopaths, or those not storing patients in the program, there is now an option to remove the password protection from RadarOpus.

#### New - Graphical revision with new icons and layout options, accessed via main options menu

- Additional customization options have been added, including 2 alternative skins to freshen up the look of the program.
  - Your chosen font and font size is now used throughout the program making it easier to read menus, tab titles and search queries.
  - You can now add/ remove icon titles in the Main Toolbar.
  - Expert tip You can enlarge the search field in the Main Toolbar for easier access to quick searching.

#### • New – List of Authors and documents

 Click VIEW – List of authors and documents – to see a full bibliographical listing of the references used in the program

#### **IMPROVEMENTS**

- Improved The first 6 icons of the Main Toolbar now act as toggle switches.
  - One click opens the TOC (table of contents). A second click closes the TOC.
- Improved Prescriptions and Pathologies section of the Patient File have been overhauled.
  - A new Notes field was added for specifying number of drops, how many succussions, or other instructions.
- Improved RadarOpus no longer needs to be restarted for a font change to be implemented.
- Improved Changed the RED color to YELLOW in the Family Finder Module.







- Improved Changed the icon for Bookmarks to help distinguish this from the stars now used to denote favorite repertories or Materia medica.
- Improved Closing the patient file automatically clears all the clipboards of that patient.
- Improved ctrl-s or ctrl-r (to save or recall an analysis) works also when the Search window is active. Note – the shortcut on Mac is cmd-s or cmd-r.
- Improved User configuration settings are now stored and recalled in the Backup/ Restore process.

#### **FIXES**

- Fixed Merge and Recall problem fixed. Previously, when you tried to merge and recall an exported/imported case, it would overwrite the existing clipboards.
- Fixed Symptom notes can now be viewed also in Silver engines
- Fixed Resolution problem which created very small text on some Windows computers
- Fixed In languages other than English, you can search for an author name with or without accents
- Removed Vithoulkas View, at the request of the author.




# **CREATE CUSTOM SYMPTOM TEMPLATES (PATIENT FILE)**








Set the template title and name Group 1 which will contain your first list of symptoms. E.G:





  - Expert tip This allows you to analyse your case in a very similar way to Dr. Master!

• Expert tip = be sure to add underlining to your symptoms – in other words, mark an intensity for each symptom to gain the maximum impact from the Master Score.

#### **About the Master Score**

Master Score is the ultimate tool to fine-tune your prescribing results using RadarOpus software. It's particularly useful for cases that need a deeper study, because it gives meaningful insights at a single glance, saving time and preventing potentially significant omissions of candidate remedies.





#### **KEY POINTS**

- Each remedy is evaluated according to the author's reference, which may be more or less reliable
- The more a remedy is referenced the more points it earns (the more authors it has as a reference)
- The method takes into account the intensity of the symptom
- The calculation will show the remedies sorted according to the value "achieved" by each remedy
- You need at least 5 symptoms for it to work

#### **HOW TO USE THE MASTER SCORE?**

Master Score, when routinely used, will be helpful to understand repertorization more deeply, which — as Dr. Farokh Master says — "has the potential to bring a new level of homeopathic practice and elevate the status of homeopathy around the world".

The beautiful part of the *Master Score* is that it filters out remedies which haven't undergone appropriate pathogenesis, in other words "cloned" remedies, (remedies that have never experienced an adequate investigation). So in a way, it is a suitable filter to have so we can be more specific when prescribing remedies.

You will enjoy using *Master Score* because you can clarify the remedy selection and drill-down into the correct remedy by asking questions based on the Materia Medica of the leading remedies in the Analysis. So, when you're looking to see what questions to ask or what remedy you want to select, you can quickly look at Materia Medica which of course is the final stage in making any prescription.

It is an Expert System in the sense that it evaluates the rubrics due to its importance. Whenever you underline, it brings up different remedies, so you can really choose what symptoms are the most important to you, as well as the remedy which has marked these symptoms.

#### This unique calculation system only exists in the Master Score within RadarOpus.






- Set your default analysis method in RadarOpus to the Master score

    - Click the symptom, then type a number from 1-9
    - Repeat for each sympom
  - Click the Chess piece icon
  - Click on Master Score Analysis











# New Free Features in v3.3

## CHOOSE FAVORITE REPERTORIES AND MATERIA MEDICA

• R-click any Repertory or Materia Medica and choose 'Add favorite' – the item is starred and the option to move it to the top of the Table of contents (TOC) is given.




Click the cog-wheel in the upper right corner of the TOC to adjust your settings to move
 Favorites to the top



- Note This process is identical for Materia Medica
- R-click on the title of any Reference to Add favorite. Click the cogwheel icon at the upper right corner of the References TOC to check the option to Display favorites at the top of the list.







 Expert tip – to see all of your favorite references at the top, regardless of their category (e.g. Materia Medica, Keynotes, Provings, etc) – uncheck the following option:



o In this case, if you have a favorite, such as *Yasgur's Dictionary*, it will still be pinned to the top even though it is classed as a Dictionary and not a Materia Medica.

# ADD LINKED SYMPTOMS FROM CONCEPTS REPERTORIES STRAIGHT TO THE CLIPBOARD

- In Concepts repertories, there are links to symptoms in Synthesis Adonis.
- You can take any number of those linked symptoms to a clipboard with a few mouse clicks.
- Instructions for use:
  - Open a Concepts repertory, such as Acute Disease (Schroyens)
  - Locate the condition with linked symptoms to Synthesis
  - Hold down ctrl (Windows) or cmd (Mac), then click on any number of linked symptoms associated with the condition. E.G.:
  - Then drag & drop the condition onto your clipboard – all the linked symptoms are automatically added to the clipboard!
    - Expert tip This can be very useful when looking up pathologies and the list of common symptoms (to know which ones are less useful in individualizing the case) but may still be appropriate.









- Instructions:
  - o On Windows, click on TOOLS OPTIONS from the main menu




- On Mac, type cmd + comma (the standard keyboard shortcut for accessing any application preferences). Or click RadarOpus (from the main menu) and select Preferences from the drop down list.
- In both cases, the General options window opens:
- It has been revamped with a new tab – Main options:
- Here you can set the FONT and FONT SIZE (which are used throughout the program, also in all the menus)
- You can choose between 4 skins








- Click on the Interface tab to continue adjusts settings/
- There are 3 new options here, found at the bottom.



- Expand or contract the size of the Menu bar SEARCH FIELD, giving easier access to the search tool
- Choose to show or hide the text under the Icons in the MAIN TOOLBAR you can save space on smaller screens by removing the text, especially if you are already familiar with their functions.
- Enable TOC icon toggle allows you to click once on e.g. the Repertories Icon to open the TOC to display all available repertories. A second click here will close the TOC. This makes it easier to open and close the TOC whilst you work. E.G. when browsing a repertory or working in the patient file, it is nice to close the TOC to work in full-screen mode.




# PATIENT FILE IMPROVEMENTS TO PRESCRIPTIONS & PATHOLOGIES

 New tabs have been created for adding prescriptions and pathologies, making the layout more clear and comprehensive, particularly for long-standing patients for whom there have been many prescriptions.



- Click on the Remedy bottle icon to open the Prescriptions Tab
- It is much easier to see the overview of your prescribing for a patient with the prescriptions moved to a dedicated tab.
  - o Fill in all the fields, then click on the ADD button



- Expert tip You can now click the down arrow to open the pick-list in any field
- A new Notes field was added for specifying details such as *number of drops, how many succussions*, or other instructions.
- Click on the MEDICAL icon to open the Pathologies tab



• Functionality is similar to adding a prescription – fill in all the fields then click the ADD button



- When adding a pathology, RadarOpus works with a specific picklist for Pathologies click the drop down arrow in the PATHOLOGY field to open the picklist, then type the name of the pathology to select it.
